Trencin 2011: A VERY FRIENDLY AND SUCCESSFUL MEETING

The 5th. Meeting of the European Network of Places of Peace was held on 30 September and 1 October 2011, in the beautiful city of Trencin, Slovakia at the invitation of the city official representative of the Network, Ms. Janka Fabová and under the support of the Self-Governing of Trencin Region, chaired by Dr. Pavol Sedláček. Significantly, the meeting was staged at the historic Trencin Castle, where were signed the Treaty of Trencin on 24 August 1335 of that year. The President of the Self-Governing of Trencin Region stressed with his personal presence his support for the project of the European Network of Places of Peace and he was delighted that the city of Trencin have been chosen to carry out the 5th. Meeting of ENPP.

The 5th Meeting reviewed the major steps taken in recent years and highlighted the recent accessions of the city of Zadar (Croatia) and the Foundation Culture of Peace, Madrid (Spain) and the presence at the meeting, as an observer, of one delegation from the city of Vasvar (Hungary).
